Illegal or unlawful activity

Sending of slanderous, libelous or defamatory e-mails

Accessing offensive, obscene or pornographic material

E-mailing offensive, obscene or pornographic material

Abusive or threatening harassment based on race, sex, religion, disability or other related status Sending anonymous messages designed to threaten, abuse or annoy recipients

Any **copyright infringement** as a result of downloading copyrighted electronic materials is the sole liability of the patron.

Offensive and/or Erroneous Material

Any material that is erroneous or may be considered offensive in nature to the user or patrons of the library is the sole responsibility of the user. Patrons viewing offensive material will be asked to leave the library. The library accepts no responsibility for the validity of information on the Internet.

Ethical use

Access to terminals is granted only on the grounds that they are used ethically. This prohibits such unethical use as unauthorised entry into other networks, accounts, breaking into network security, removing or damaging hardware, etc.

Printing is available in black and white, or colour. All printing must be paid for. Please consult library staff for printing costs.

Access to Internet terminals is allowed at the discretion of the library staff. Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated. Repeated incidents of misuse of Internet access will result in access being denied or, in extreme cases, users will be banned from the library.
